7. **Blue Voice** **M. Millsaps, Chief of Police**
The Town Council will consider a service contract with Blue Voice, a specialized AI platform developed exclusively for Law Enforcement. This tool provides officers with immediate, real-time access to the North Carolina General Statutes and Department Policy Manuals. There is no annual cost for the first year of service, while the second year carries an annual fee of \$3,500.00.
