

## **REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**

October 2, 2012

The regular meeting was opened for business by Mayor Holleman at 5:30 p.m. The invocation was given by Mayor Holleman. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Karen Martin spoke concerning the construction activity of the Milstead Woods apartment complex near her home located on School Drive. She noted that construction vehicles were parking in the roadway, sometimes blocking driveways during unloading of materials during late night hours making lots of noise. Some ruts have been made in neighbor's yards. Town Manager, David Odom stated that the contractor has been made aware of the neighbor's concerns and that any deterioration to the adjoining neighbor's yards made by the construction will be addressed & corrected.

Mayor Holleman noted the leaning power pole at the ABC store and also at Town & Country Drugs. Duke Power will be contacted about the issue.

There were no other comments in open forum.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lerner and seconded by Commissioner Robinette to approve the agenda as presented. The motion was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lerner and seconded by Commissioner Robinette to approve the minutes as presented for the September 4, 2012 regular called meeting. The motion was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Poole and seconded by Commissioner Elliott to approve the audit presentation of the FY 2011-2012 financial statements for the Town as presented by Martin Starnes & Associates, contingent upon LGC approval. The GF available fund balance is \$477,227.00 & the W&S cash flow from operations was \$1,010,054.00. Completed copies of the proposed financial statements are available in the Town Hall. The motion was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Poole and seconded by Commissioner Elliott to approve \$300.00 allocation for the Taylorsville Apple Festival. The motion was passed unanimously.

David Robinette, Public Works Director noted that the sewer improvements are almost completed around June Bug Loop. We will be taking bids on the paving of the street.

The standard police report was submitted. It was noted that the traffic patrol around the high

school has been increased due to the heavy volume of traffic.

Town Manager, David Odom has been working on town beautification efforts. Milstead Woods project is nearing completion.

The November meeting is set for November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at 5:30pm. With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned.
